They seem to have expanded their services and the area they now cover -now covering the whole of the UK-

They appear to have 'turned the corner' since the last Report compiled on here in 2009/10. They appear to be a highly impressive org providing much benefit for animals and their carers/guardians-although the Salaries they pay do appear to have a large number on what would be considered "excessive' and it has to be questioned as to how this may affect the price that people may have to pay for their Veterinary Services..
